Re fireworks

Regular meeting of the Commissioners February 2, 1961

Meeting called to order at 8.00 P M at the New telephone office at Bay Veiw, by the chairman Mr. Malone.

Minutes of the last meeting on January 5, 1961 read and approved and read.

Secretary Hunter reported that he had talked to Mr. Lang the County treasurer last week, and Mr. Lang told him that \$ 5000 of coupon warrants plus interest had been paid in early January.

Current bills were considered and vouchers for same approved and signed.

Chief Hunter had a resolution copy on hand, which was supporting Senate bill No 6 indirectly, in that it was urging other communities to help abolish fireworks by state law. If passed it was to be sent the Seattle, King County, Safety Council for their use in helping to get Senate bill No 6 passed. It was discussed at length. Also the pros and cons of fireworks. Mr. Malone was for control of fireworks, but on a local level. Mr. Henny also concurred in this feeling.

Mr. Malone makes motion to adopt resolution No 26 ~~endorsing~~ endorsing the Safety Councils efforts.

Chief Hunter presented his annual report for the year of 1960, furnishing a copy for each of the Commissioners.

There being no further business meeting was adjourned at 9.20 PM.
