SPECIAL COMMISSIONERS MEETING

JUNE 16, 1983

Purpose: To assign district's insurance agent for 1983-1984, and to discuss the painting of the Freeland Fire Station.

The meeting was called to order at 3:00 p.m. by Chairman Gary Gabelein. In attendance were Byron Worland, Kenneth McClellan and Bruce Klassen.

Discussion and agreement on district's satisfaction with current insurance agent (Stuurmans).

Kenneth McClellan made a motion to remain with Stuurmans as agent of record, and to look at alternatives again next year. Byron Worland seconded the motion; motion carried.

Discussion ensued with regard to painting the Freeland station to improve its appearance until such time as it can be remodeled entirely.

The commissioners agreed that prices should be shopped and, if under \$1,000, have the job awarded to the lowest competent painter meeting the specs. If more than \$1,000, then the district will call for bids.

Byron Worland made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Kenneth McClelland seconded the motion; motion carried. Meeting was adjourned at 3:23 p.m.
