Regular meeting of the Commissioners July 7, 1960.

Meeting was called early at 7.00 P.M. at Mr. Paul Brovers place at Freeland near the seventh Day Adventists Church.

The lot fronts on the highway and is located about 200 feet east of the church. It lays well as to elevation being about at road level and level. It is covered with barreis vines, brush, small seedling trees, and a few small stumps. Would not be too hard to get in shape for moving the Freeland fire station onto.

It is disscussed but no action is taken.

Mr. Cappn thanks Mr. Brower and the Commissioners travel from here to north side of Jack Daniels place which lays south of the Freeland Service Station of Jack Daniels about 600 feet.

Mr. Daniels has said that he would give the distri ct a lot on the north side of his place on which to move the fire station, and the Commissioners look over the approximate location,

Due to the fact that the exact location of the new highway is not yet determined Mr. Daniels could not show the exact spot he could give, so it was only generalized as to location.

This looks like a likly spot but no one will know until next year for sure just where the new road will go, so it looks as if we will just have to wait it out.

There was considerable disscussion but again, no action taken on the offer of Mr. Daniels.

From this spot the meeting was transferred to the home of Mr. Caop for the final portion, which would take care of the regular business of the district.

The report from Island County Treasurer Harry Lang, in regard to the financial condition of the district was examined by all the Commissioners and approved. It showed a net balance on lay flat of \$ 6055.63 with warrants payable outstanding of the amount of \$ 143.29

Current bills were considered and vouchers for same were approved and signed.

Chief Hunter again brought up the matter of the two Pacific mercury 1500 watt generators he had requested earlier in the year and stated they were on hand and he had used them on several occasions and\*\*\* when the electric power was off and that they were needed by the district. He had a voucher prepared and it was approved and signed. The generators were being sold by the Givers Company of Bellevue to the district at a ten % discount which would make the net price \$ 635.40 *incl tax*

This was the last business to consider so the meeting was adjourned at 9.15 P.M.
