ISLAND COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT No 3

Regular meeting of the Commissioners March 8, 1962.

Meeting called to order at 7.30 PM at the home of the secretary M.E. Hunter at Midvale, by Mr. Malone chairman. This meeting having been postponed from the previous Thursday because of snow and cold, making it hazardous driving on the highway.

Minutes of the last meeting on February 1, 1962 were read and approved as read.

Current bills were considered and vouchers for same approved and signed.

County Treasures report to the district is on hand and shows a balance of \$ 245.57 on hand with warrants in the amount of \$ 68.26 outstanding as of January 31, 1961.

Mr Capp reports on a talk he had had with Jack Daniels regarding the station building at Freeland. Jack indicated that he and Chuck Rosemeyer had been placed on a committee to look into the matter of a location for the station to be moved to. Also in the matter of a size for the lot that would be needed for same.

Hunter reported that he had talked with Andy Andrews <sup>Hays</sup> that this morning and that Andy had said that Everett had allegedly said that he would give a lot for the Station. Andy also said that the road which the County had put down past the bowling alley to intercept the new highway would remain as a County road even though the access to the new road might be changed back to the original plan, ie, ~~at the~~ near the church.

Hunter reported that he had talked with Chuck Rosemeyer during the day regarding he and Jack on the committee. Chuck said he thought that the fire district should furnish a lot for the station, feeling that it would be hard to go to the people in the community and ask for funds to buy with, as they had provided money once before for the ~~propose~~ purpose.

Hunter is instructed to talk to Everett Hays regarding a lot he is reported willing to lease to the district,

Also is instructed to see Mr. Magnuson regarding a lot.

Hunter explains need for power supply and transmitter for one of the 4 tanker radios to make it a two way radio.

Mr. Capp makes motion to purchase same at approximately \$ 31500 as matching funds are not now available for radio. Seconded by Malone carried.

Much discussion regarding lot and Hunter reports Sanders lot still available.
