Regular meeting of the commissioners Dec. 20, 1956.

Meeting called to order at the home of the chairman Mr. Palmerston at 8.00 P.M. (Mr. Palmerston had been ill)

Mr. Palmerston asked if any of the others had thought about or considered radio equipment for the trucks, stating that he had. Chief Hunter said he had thought some about it. No action.

Chief Hunter brought up the problem of sirens for the various stations, and recommended we buy used one horse power siren from Snohomish Co, Fire Dist. # 1 which will soon be available. He also recommended we buy a horse power siren from Curtis & sons. Permission to do so was granted to Hunter. Mr. Palmerston stated that Clinton Commercial Club had mentioned that they might buy a 2 H.P. siren which Hunter had borrowed from Curtis & Sons. The commissioners also granted Hunter permission to buy this siren if Clinton did not buy it.
