Regular meeting of the commissioners March 13, 1959

Meeting called to order at the home of the chairman
Mr. Palmerston at 8.00 P.M.

Commissioners Present : Harry F. Palmerston

Current bills considered and vouchers for same approved and signed.

The secretary reported that Mr. Rolfe of General Electric had told him that if the commissioners would give them (G.E.) a letter to the effect that if the F.C.D.A. matching funds were delayed more than 120 days after the completion date of installation of the radio equipment in the district trucks that they (the commissioners) would issue coupon warrants to G.E. on a short term basis to cover the F.C.D.A. half of the cost of the equipment, and to be returned to the district when the F.C.D.A. warrant came through and was delivered to them, then the equipment would be shipped out as soon as possible.

This is agreed to by the commissioners and Mr. Palmerston agrees to form up the letter and mail it as soon as possible.

Resolution # 19 passed to accomplish this and becomes a part of these minutes.

No further business meeting was adjourned at 9.00 P.M.
