ISLAND COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT No 3

Special meeting of the Commissioners June 13, 1963, at 7.50 PM, at the office of the Whidbey Telephone Company at Bay Veiw.

Meeting called to order by the Chairman Mr. Malone, with the following Meeting called to consider bids for District liability insurance for the fiscal year June 15, 1963 to June 15, 1964.

Mr. Scott Brewer and Mr. Ralph Noble are on hand as representatives of their respective Companies.

Mr. Brewer had previously made a bid of \$ 887.10 for policy offering coverage of \$ 250 deductible, \$ 25000 PD and \$ 100,000- \$ 300,000 BI with General Insurance Company.

Mr. Noble now makes abid of \$ 1007.86 for the same coverage, but after hearingt the bid of Mr. Brewer, he says he cant better it, so decides to leave. He is thanked and bid good eveneing.

The bid of Kehle & Hawley, representing the group insurance of the Washington Sta te Fire Commissioners Association, is read, and reveals a figure of \$ 775.25 for the above coverage. This is \$ 111.85 below the bid of Mr. Brewer.

After much disscussion by the Commissioners and Mr. Brewer and Hunter, Mr. Brewer states he will lower his bid by reducing his commission \$ 45.00 making his bid \$ 842.10. This leaves a difference of \$ 66.85 between his bid and the bid of Kehle & Hawly in thair favor.

The matter id disscussed further, and Hunter states that Kehle & Hawley advise that a local agent can be named by the District. ~~who will receive the bid and the commission on the policy, and~~ Hunter suggests that Mr, Brewer can be named if he so desires. Mr. Brewer seems to be not receptive to this idea.

After more disscussion, Hunter is instructed to call Kehle & Hawley in the morning and learn the name of the Company with whom they plave ~~this~~ this insurance, also learn what duties a local agent would have in connection with the policy, and the holder.

9.00 oclock and it is decided to hold up a decision in the matter until after the abpve information is received. Mr. Brewere is thanked and meeting is adjourned.
