

Regular meeting of the Commissioners February 1, 1962

Meeting called to order by the Chairman Mr. Malone at 7.35 PM at the Whidbey Telephone Company office at Bay View.

Minutes of the last regular meeting of January 4 read and approved as read.

Current bills in the total amount of \$ 510.71 considered and vouchers for same approved and signed.

County Treasurers report for the month of december 1961 is on hand and shows a balance of \$ 4562.60 with warrants in the amount of \$ 68.26 outstanding as of December 31, 1961.

Hunter reported on the Freeland Merchants meeting he had attended on the second Tuesday in January. He Spoke to the meeting in behalf of the fire department there stressing the need for more volunteer firemen at Freeland, and requesting the merchants there to put forth more effort to recruit men.

He also stated that Mrs Harpham had said at that meeting that she still wanted the fire hall moved from her property, in the future and although it was not real urgent she didnt want it forgotten.

Hunter also reported that he and several of the firemen there had moved part of the partition in the hall to make room for the new truck when it is received.

The question of Mrs Sanders giving a lot from her place for the station site was discussed, and Hunter was instructed to contact her and find out if the offer was still good, and also just where the lot would be, and report to the next Commissioners meeting regarding same.

Hunter also reported that Jack Daniels had reported at the Freeland Merchants meeting that the State had turned him down on and approach to the new road from his place, which would effectually kill any use of the lot on his place for a site for the station, this putting the problem back where it was two years ago.

Hunter suggested that it might do some good if the Commissioners talked to the folks at Freeland including Al Price who is the new president of the group there.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 8.40 PM.
