REGULAR MEETING OF COMMISSIONERS

March 6, 1980

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Gary Gabelein at 7:30 P. M., others in attendance were Commissioners Kenneth G. McClellan, and Byron Worland, Asst. Kenneth McClellan moved that the minutes of the previous regular meeting be approved as written, Byron Worland seconded the motion, motion carried.

Kenneth McClellan reporting for the Chief, passed around brochures and data on an ambulance type of vehicle, there was much discussion on the subject.

Ron and Gary Wallin discussed ambulance problems and also the possibility of a third ambulance, if the ambulance levy is approved in the fall election. They also gave suggestions about different types of vehicles for the Commissioners consideration.

Gary Gabelein gave a report on his attendance at the Commissioners Seminar at Mount Vernon and found much helpful information there.

After discussing the budget extension of \$11,707.14, Byron Worland moved that resolution No. 80-02 be adopted, to increase the District budget by that amount, Kenneth McClellan seconded the motion, the motion carried unanimously.

District No. 5 Commissioner Leroy Hanken discussed the possibility of their District purchasing some of our surplus Electrons, it was decided to let Chief Paul Nichol negotiate with District No. 5.

After checking the vouchers in the amount of \$6,213.41, Byron Worland moved that they be approved, Kenneth McClellan seconded the motion, the motion carried.
