Chief Hunter was asked if he wanted to attend The Red Cross First Aid Teachers Trainingg classes to be held in Everett starting in February, also the Fire Officers training classes starting in Everett in early January. He said he would , so a motion was made and seconded to pay Chief Hunters expenses in attending these classes.

There was some disscussion about the Free land fire hall moving or building a new one, but no action taken.

Mr Capp reported that Jack Daniels said that if the Fire Commissionerev would write a letter to the property man of General Petoleum Corp. Asking for a lot 40 x 70 feet at the back corner of his lot he th ought they would give the district a long term lease on it for perhaps a dollar a year.

Chief Hunter requested the Commissioners to call for bids on the radio eq uipment for the district in order to conform to the re-quirments of the law on these matters. This call to be in the local paper for the necessary number of times, also to notify General Mlectric and Motorola by letter, the secretary to specify the date bids are to be opened.

The secretary set the date of February 4 th as the opening date, as that was the earliest date that they could be received, allowing the bidders time to formulate their bids adn present them.

There being no further business meeting was adjourned 9.00 P.M.
