Regular meeting of the Commissioners May 5, 1960

Meeting called to order at the home of the chairman Mr. Palmerston at 8.00 P.M.

Current bills considered and vouchers for same approved and signed.

County Treasurers report to the district on the district's finances was considered and accepted.

Chief Hunter reported that the coats ordered by the district for the firemen were to be delivered this week.

Hunter also reported on the two 1500 watt generators and submitted a bid price for them from the ~~Andy Johnson Company~~ Bob Givens company. The price was \$ 611.00 plus sales tax of \$24.40. *per each.*

~~Resolution No~~ was passed stating that the district would apply for Civil Defense matching funds to help pay for the generators.

Chief Hunter reported that he had contacted Al Cammondona in regard to two alternators he has on two Chevrolet trucks which he will dispose of. He wishes two regular generators and regulators for the two trucks and a ring and valve job on the pickup truck for the two alternators. Hunter reported that the two alternators would be put on the Bush Point Dodge and on the Freeland truck if we acquired them and he recommended that they get them, as they would keep up the batteries on the trucks better than the small ones on the trucks at present.

Motion made and carried that Chief Hunter should go ahead with the deal.

Chief Hunter reported that the State Firemen's convention would be at Port Angeles on June 22, 23, 24, 25, and stated he would like to go if the district would pay his ~~the~~ expenses. Motion was made and carried to send Hunter to the convention.

Hunter reported that the insurance would be due in June on the trucks. There was some discussion of the insurance, and Scott Brewer is to be asked to be at the next meeting to talk over and explain the insurance to the Commissioners.

Mr William Bonser editor of the Whidbey Island Record was ~~there~~ on hand by invitation to note how meetings were carried on.

No further business meeting was adjourned at 9.20 P.M. after which Mrs Palmerston served tea and cake to those present. (very good cake too)
