Regular meeting of the Commissioners December 11, 1959.

Meeting called to order at the home of the chairman Mr. Palmerston at 8.00 P.M.

Current bills considered and vouchers for same approved and signed.

Mr. A.R. Colvin Commissioner from Island County Fire Protection District No 5 is on hand.

Mr Colvin has a resolution which he explains to the Commissioners. The resolution proposes to establish an Island County Fire protection Bureau, which would consist of , a Fire Protection Chief, an assistant to the Chief, and deputys in the persons of the Chiefs of the various fire districts. The County Engineer would be the Bureau Chief.

The resolution which Mr Colvin has, would be presented to the Island County Commissioners, with the request that they passit.

Mr Colvin stated that he was going to get the resolution approved by the commissioners of the several Fire Districts in the County before presenting it to the County Commissioners.

Mr Palmerston made motion which was seconded, to give approval to the resolution.

Copies of the resolution was delivered to the Commissioners and the secretary.

The secretary reminded the Commissioners that the term of the Chief Hunter was expiring the first of the year.

Mr Capp made motion which was seconded by Mr Palmerston that Chief Hunter be reappointed for another two year term.

Chief Hunter told the Commissioners that the district should start proceedings soon for matching funds for two 1500 watt generators for the district, one to be carried on the Chief's pickup and the other for power for the base station.

No further business meeting was adjourned at 930 P.M.
