

ISLAND COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT No. 3
Regular Commissioners meeting of May 3, 1979

The meeting was called to order by chairman Byron Worland at 7:32 P. M. In attendance were Commissioners Kenneth G. McClellan and Gary R. Gabelein, Chief Paul Nichol, Secretary Randolph Erikson and *sig* Worland.

Kenneth McClellan moved that the reading of the minutes of the previous meeting be dispensed with, motion seconded by Gary Gabelein, motion carried.
