Regular meeting of the Commissioners November 1, 1962 at 7.30 P.M.

Meeting called to order by the chairman Mr. Malene at the Whidbey Telephone Company at Bay Veiw.

Minutes of the last meeting on October 4 1962 read and approved as read.

County Treasurer report is on hand and shows a balance on hand of ~~\$6206.66~~ <sup>5234.96</sup> with warrants in the amount of \$ ~~42.60~~ <sup>611.10</sup> outstanding as of ~~October 31 st.~~ <sup>Sept 29</sup>

Site for the Freeland Station was discussed, and Hunter reported that he had talked to Everett Hayes regarding his lot, but that Hayes did not commit himself further than he had previously. Hunter agreed to talk to Hayes further.

Hunter reported on the problem of heating the various stations. Stated that the oil heaters were not too satisfactory as they had to be started each time weather turned cold and then turned off or down at the end of cold spell, and it was always a worry for fear a stove would go out. Also it was impossible to heat some of the halls warm enough for a meeting. Stated that Saragoga station had a gas heater which had been working very well for six years. The cost for heat would probably be a little higher but would be much more satisfactory.

Hunter said he would like to try a gas heater in the Clinton hall first and if it proved to be OK then suggested that the district put them in the rest of the halls eventually.

Hunter said he had talked to Howard Rowe, and Rowe said the Petrolane Liquified Gas Company would let us have a 75000 BTU heater new, for \$ 160 which is about wholesale, as they sell for About \$ 225.00 retail.

Motion made by Mr. Capp and seconded by Mr. Henry for Hunter to buy one of these heaters for the Clinton Station. This price does not include accessory items or instalation, but Hunter can install heater.

This is all the business so meeting is adjourned at 8.50
