REGULAR MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS 4 MARCH 1971

Meeting called to order by Mr. Henny the Chairman at 7.00PM at the Clinton Fire station.

Commissioners present: David C. Henny
Lloyd S. Capp
Joseph H. Long

Minutes of the last meeting on 4 February read and approved as read.

Current bills in the amount of \$ 1724.08 from the firms and individuals listed on the reverse side this sheet are on hand and examined. Mr. Capp makes motion seconded by Mr. Long that they be allowed and vouchers approved and signed. Carried.

County Treasurers report is on hand and shows a balance in the expense fund of \$ 3364.87 with warrants in the amount of \$ 810.07 outstanding as of 31 January. Taxes collected during the month were \$ 147.73 The GO bond fund shows a balance of \$6628.29 with interest of \$ 125.00 having been paid and taxes in the amount of \$ 83.22 being received, as of the same date.

There was discussion regarding taxes in an informal way. Millages, collections etc.

There was also some discussion regarding the new station wagon which has been ordered, as to delivery date.

Under new business Mr. Capp states that Mr. John Bakker who had given the District a 1956 Ford panel last year, had asked the District to use it. Mr. Bakker would like to have it back if the District did not intend to use it. The Chief says it has been used some in the past time but it is not suitable for the purpose required of it as to size of body etc, also it needs another engine, he feels it is not advisable to spend the money for this. Mr. Capp makes motion seconded by Mr. Long that the machine be given back to Mr. Bakker with the stipulation that the District retain the red revolving light mounted on the top and the siren also mounted on it. The Freeland department had bought and installed them. Motion is carried.

The secretary now requests a new printing duplicator to be purchased, as the used one purchased from the State warehouse several years ago and at present being used is not very satisfactory as it takes too long to set up and wastes a large amount of paper. The machine he feels would be satisfactory is a hand cranked machine listed in the Sears Roebuck catalog for \$88.88 ~~sales catalog~~ at a reduction of \$ 16.07 from the regular price in the big catalog. This price is good only until the eighth. Mr. Capp makes motion seconded by Mr. Long that the secretary go ahead and purchase this machine, carried.

This concludes the business and meeting is adjourned at 8.00
