Meeting called to order by Mr. Hunter, the Chairman, in the meeting room in the Clinton fire station at 7:02 P. M.

This meeting was called for the purpose of opening bids on the new fire station at Bayview and the addition to the present fire station at Saratoga.

The Chairman dispenses with reading of the minutes of last meeting of April 1, 1976 at this time, as they are not pertinent to this meeting.

Bidders present are: John Parkhurst of Parkhurst & Lang; Dave Eggiman & Arthur Kinskie of The Building Co. Inc.; Carl & Roy Simmons of Simmons Builders; Bob Alexander, Al Alexander & Bob Keyes of Alexander Construction; Ivan & Ray Richardson.

Visitors present are: Marvyn Berkeland, Gary Gabelein, Charles Miller, Wm. Bone, Lincoln Wildes, Terry Hornshaw and Manfred Veit.

Mr. McClellan reports that in talking to Mr. Hinchee, building inspector, that he says he will not issue a permit based on present set of plans.

Mr. McClellan also wishes to go on record as stating that he could not endorse a motion for awarding a contract until this is straightened out.

The Chairman states that this meeting is for bid opening only, and no contract will be awarded at this time.

The Secretary is now instructed to proceed with the opening of the bids on the Bayview station. As these are opened they are handed to the Chairman to read. The bids are listed below:

The date of April 26, 1976 is decided on as this is the earliest date we could advertise in the paper.
