Regular meeting of the Commissioners August 5, 1959.

Chief Hunter reports that a phone ~~has~~ is needed at the Bush Point station.

Mr. Palmerston makes motion and is passed that a phone be installed.

Hunter reports that a new development at Mutiny Bay called Mutiny Bay Sands is under way, and that they are planning a water system consisting of a well with 500 gal per minute pump, 30,000 storage tank, and six inch mains through the tract which will be a very good thing for the fire district for ~~water supply~~ supply for the trucks.

Chief Hunter reports that so far this year Fire alarms are few and far between, grass and brush fires being at the lowest abb for several years.

Chief Hunter reported that he had purchased a 90 gal per min te portable water pump, which he would carry on the truck he drives and the district could use and pay him for it next year, as he feels it more necessary to purchase some light weight ~~hh~~ linen hose 1 1/2 inch to use with the pump, with what money the district has, than to pay him for the pump at this time.

Hunter buys 90 gal P.M. pump w own money to be reimbursed at a later time

Hunter was instructed to check and get prices on 1 1/2 linen hose.

Hunter also reported that the district request for F.C.D.A matching funds for the radio had been approved.

Hunter also reported that the signs for Bush Point , and Sar atogs fire stations had been finished and delivered.

Hunter also reported that after Sept 21st no matching fund requests for radio equipment would be considered unless standby power plant of sufficient capacity and automa tic switching gear was already installed at the base station with 14 day gas supply. Some discussion but no action taken.
