

Island County Fire Protection District No. 3  
Regular meeting of the Commissioners  
September 6, 1979

Meeting was called to order by acting chairman Gary Gabelein at 7:31 P. M.

In attendance, Commissioner Kenneth McClellan, Chief Paul Nichol,  
As'st. Chief Marvyn Berkeland, Secretary Randolph Erikson.

Kenneth McClellan moved that the minutes of the previous meeting be approved as written, motion seconded by Gary Gabelein, motion carried.

Vouchers in the amount \$3,823.63 were presented and on motion of Kenneth McClellan for approval, seconded by Gary Gabelein, motion carried.

Kenneth McClellan moved to approve of twenty two cents (.22¢) as the amount of reimbursement for the use of private cars on a per mile basis, for District use, motion seconded by Gary Gabelein, motion carried.

Subjects of discussion from Commissioners were: Town of Langley to be notified of increase in dispatching fee.

Training procedures of Telephone Co. operators as fire dispatchers.

Central location of fuel supplies for District vehicles.

Possibly more use of credit cards for purchase of fuel.

Billing of State agencies for fire protection.

Cleaning and care of fire stations and possible ways and means to accomplish same.

After the meeting had been interrupted by a call for the Jaws of Life at the scene of a one vehicle accident on the Maxwellton Rd., which turned out to be a successful demonstration of the proper use of this tool, the Commissioners returned to study the budget.

After detailed study of the various items in the budget, Gary Gabelein moved to adopt resolution No. 101, approving the 1980 budget in the amount of \$185,698.46, motion seconded by Kenneth McClellan, motion carried.
