Regular meeting of the Commissioners Sept 14, 1963.

This meeting had been postponed from the regular meeting date of the first Thursday because of the unavailability of several members of the group.

Meeting called to order at the home of the secretary M.E. Hunter at Midvale at 3.45 PM by the chairman Mr. Malone.

County Treasurers report on hand and it shows a balance on hand of \$ 5198.00 with warrants in the amount of \$ 42.60 outstanding as of August*, July 31

Vouchers for current bills considered and signed.


Hunter reported that the drain and water lines had been installed at Maxwellton.

The budget for the year 1963 was considered and motion to adopt resolution # 31 showing an increase of P* approximately 10 % over the expected revenue for the year is passed. Amount is: \$ 19,462.00

Hunter reported that the Sandy Point people are holding out on the town of Langley on a rate increase for the water supplied to the point. They feel that if they are to pay more for their water they should get lower insurance rates.

Hunter repeated his request for permission to remove the engine, pump and tank from truck # 2 so that he could use the truck for a service truck to drive about the district about district business, as he would be able to carry tools and other material he needs in connection with the job of maintenance on buildings and equipment. No action taken, except under advisement.

Business was concluded and meeting adjourned at 4,30 PM.
