Regular meeting of the Commiesiners June 10, 1959.

Meeting called to order at the home of the chairman Mr. Palmerston at 8.00 P.M.

Current bills considered and vouchers for same approved and signed.

Mr. Palmerston reported that Battallion Chief Al Christensen of the Bush Point department had told him they were ready for a sign on the new station at Bush Point. It was disscussed and Chief Hunter suggested a size of 2 feet by 16 feet would be right for the station. Sign to be made of galvanized iron sheet with wood border.

Lettering on the sign to include the words Volunteer Fire Dept., that passersby would know it was stictly volunteer, also to help boost the morale of the men in the department, to be publicly recognized for their effort for the community.


Chief Hunter asked for a sign for the Saratoga Fire Station also..

Mr. Palmerston made motion to furnish signs for both places, which was seconded and carried, and Mr. Malone agreed to see Ran Crawford about making the signs.

The copy of the lease from the General Petroleum Corporation was disscussed . This was to provide a lot at Freeland to either move the old station to, or , to build a new station on.

This lease only provided a 12 month positive time , and thereafter on a 30 day notice by either party. It was not deemed acceptable and the secretary was instructed to write a letter of rejection , with thanks to the Oil Company.
