ISLAND COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT No 3

Regular meeting of the Commissioners June 7, 1962

Meeting called to order by the Chairman Mr. Malone at 7.30 P.M. at the Whidbey Telephone Company office at Ba y Veiw.

Minutes of the last meeting on May 3, 1962 read and approved as read.

County Treasurers report is on hand and shows a balance on hand as of April 30 of \$ \$ 7771.75 with warrants in the amount of \$ 1315.74 outstanding.

Vouchers in the amount of \$ 962.90 for current bills are approved and signed.

Hunter brought up the matter of the price the district was paying for gasoline stating that the only saving under the present method of purchase was the 4¢ per gallon federal tax which the gas companies deduct when purchases are made on a credit card, and that the District could buy direct from Standard Oil at the County price of .2033 cents per gallon.

Hunter said he had a new 550 gallon tank that the Distict could use along with the pump if the District would pay for digging out the old tank and for the fittings necessary to hook up same. He feelse that in veiw of the needs for so many things that the District can not buy at present because of lack of funds, that if the District can save more than one third on the cost of the gasoline used by the trucks, it should be done, and this is one way of saving up to \$ 150 a year.

It is disscussed and motion is made to go ahead if the instalation cost is within reason.

Hunter requested the District to pay his fery expense when he has to go to the mainland on District business, stating that in times past he had absorbed the cost by combining his trips with his business trips and then writing it off as a business, but now he does not go over for that reason anymore.

Motion is made to pay these fery expenses made for District business.

Mr. Henny requested Hunter to bring up any problems ~~with the~~ that he may have relative the various stations, at each monthly meeting.

This is the concluding business so meeting is adjourned at 9.15
