Mr. Capp reported that he and Hunter had attended the meeting of the Island County Hospital District Commissioners, along with several of the Commissioners from Districts five and two, on July 16. The hospital commissioners stated that their plans included the continuing levying of one mil of taxes from the Junior tax, during the next several years. They said that the application which they had made to the Federal government for Hill Burton funds included the levying of this one mil of taxes, and they could do nothing to help the fire districts by reducing this tax.

A preliminary tax valuation figure for district three of \$ 5,044,252.00 is on hand. This shows an increase of \$ 418,100.00 over 1964.

The budget for 1965 is discussed briefly, but no action is taken.

Hunter requests the Commissioners to come to the Freeland station one of these days for an inspection of what he has been doing there, and what he would like to do there. Mr. Capp agrees to stop there on his way home from this meeting.

This concludes the meeting and it is adjourned at 7.10
