

ISLAND COUNTY FIRE DISTRICT NO.3

REGULAR MEETING OF JUNE 11, 1985

Chairman Byron Worland called the meeting to order at 7:04 p.m. Also present were Gary Gabelein, Bruce Klassen, Paul Busch and Hazel Dodsworth.

No visitors were in attendance.

Gary Gabelein made a motion to accept the minutes of the last regular meeting of May 14th, and the minutes of the Local Board for Volunteer Firemen (also of May 14th), as written. Byron Worland seconded the motion; motion carried.

Air Packs: Addressing the Chief's Report to the Commissioners, requesting permission to purchase three new air packs, Gary Gabelein made a motion to purchase the units in accordance with the Chief's specifications outlined in his Report. This would bring the District into compliance with Washington State Safety Standards for Firefighters. Byron Worland seconded the motion; motion carried.


Dodge Pickup (4 x 4): The Chief informed the commissioners that the District is in line to receive, at no cost (other than license fees and replacement of clutch), a Dodge Pickup. the Board agreed that Chief Klssen should go ahead and procure the 4 x 4 vehicle.

Sno-Isle Commissioners - 106% Levy Lid: The commissioners felt that they should decide upon raising the levy lid at a future date when the need arose and when other districts were planning to raise their levy lids.

Bush Point Station: It was pointed out to the commissioners that in spite of several promises to finish the work at the Bush Point Station, Bill Kohlwes had failed to do so. In view of the many months that had gone by, the commissioners directed the Chief to inform Bill that unless the leaking roof and sheet rock work had been completed by him before the next regular meeting of the Commissioners (July 9, 1985), the District would employ someone else to proceed with the work and have Bill Kohlwes pay for all costs involved. Gary Gabelein instructed the Chief to proceed with getting estimates for the sheet rock and roofing repairs immediately. Byron Worland suggested that Jerry Thorn be asked to submit a bid on the Bush Point work, and to take a look at the Clinton station also.

Gary Gabelein made a motion to pay the bills as presented. Byron Worland seconded the motion; motion carried.

Byron Worland made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:35p.m. Gary Gabelein seconded the motion; motion carried.
