

ISLAND COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO.3

REGULAR MEETING OF NOVEMBER 12, 1985

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Byron Worland at 7:00 p.m. Also present were Gary Gabelein, Kenneth McClellan, Bruce Klassen, Hazel Dodsworth, and Paul Busch.

Saratoga Water

There was some discussion regarding the poor water pressure at Saratoga Fire Station. The Chief pointed out, however, that he had been informed that in order to increase the water pressure at that location the Water Company would have to tunnel under the road and the project would be quite expensive, costing approximately \$1,000. The commissioners suggested that the Chief approach the Water district and ask if they would be prepared to split the cost of improving the water flow.

FIREMEN'S PENSION FEES

There was a brief discussion in regard to Fire District No.3 picking up the cost of the firemen's pension fees. The commissioners asked the Chief to check with Joe Faubion againto be sure there was no problem from that direction.
