REGULAR MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS DECEMBER 4, 1969

Meeting called to order by the chairman Mr. Henny at 7.00 P.M. at the Clinton fire station.

Commissioners present: David C. Henny
Joseph H. Long

Minutes of the last meeting on 6 November read and approved as read.

Current bills in the amount of \$ 2401.86 are on hand and examined and Mr. Long makes motion seconded by Mr. Henny that they be allowed and vouchers signed, carried. They are listed the reverse side this sheet.

Under new business the Chief requests that there be purchased 500 feet of 1 1/2 inch hose, so that there will be at least a partial change of dry hose at the time of a fire and hose is used and needs to be cleaned and dried. 500 feet is not enough for a complete change but will fill minimum needs until more can be purchased. The need for spare 2 1/2 hose is mentioned but not requested at this time.

The Chief is asked what type he would recommend and he feels the all synthetic more commonly known as polyester hose should be purchased. It usually runs about 20 to 30 % more than the cotton hose but can be washed and reloaded immediately.

Mr. Long now makes motion seconded by Mr. Henny that the Chief go ahead and order 500 feet of this hose, carried. He is to get prices from more than one supplier, ~~carried~~.

A pitot ~~set~~ set for testing the firepumps on the trucks is briefly mentioned, no action.

Hunter is asked jokingly, if Marv is earning his pay. He replies that He has worked almost steady since being hired, for his \$ 200 per month and has not needed to do but little for the water district for his \$ 250 per month.

Mr. Henny is short of time and, there being no more urgent business meeting is adjourned at 7.30.
