

The Chief now brings up the question of smoke detectors for the fire stations, which would activate the station sirens. There is some discussion with Mr. Gabelein, who sells these, but no action.

Mr. Gabelein also said he would supply battery operated smoke detectors to firemen and Commissioners at a cost of \$40.00.

The Chairman asks the Chief in regard to door closing after trucks leave the stations, which to date has not been resolved. He feels at this time that this is a priority over smoke detectors, as by closing doors after the truck leaves station, unauthorized persons could not easily enter station and maliciously set fire, as happened recently in Everett. D.C.C.

Attention is now directed to the problem with the large door in the Freeland station closing when radio is keyed as the truck leaves the station. This has not been resolved and it is suggested that the Chief contact the Stanley Door people with the problem to learn if they can solve it.

The Chief now reports that the rest room screen and counter in kitchen area of upstairs at Freeland station has been largely completed.

Mr. Hunter suggests to the Chief that he get formica for the counter tops at Clinton and Maxwellton stations in addition to at Freeland station.

Business is now concluded and meeting is adjourned at 9:00 P. M.
