hand to discuss our radio needs for the district.

They assured the commissioners that they could and would  
take care of the details of applying for FCC radio license  
and Civil Defense matching funds.

Chief Hunter made a report on the results of two radio  
surveys which he and Mr. Wold made on two previous Saturdays  
which surveys were very satisfactory.

On the basis of the second survey made it was decided that the  
base station should be installed at Midvale at Chief Hunters  
home, as it is nearly centrally located in the district, and  
seemed to give best results.

Mr Wold submitted a firm bid price ~~of~~ of \$ 5465.10 for the  
following radio equipment: Price not including tax of 3 1/2 percent

- 1,- 50 watt base station.
  - 1,- 6 mobile two way 50 watt units.
  - 1,- 20 watt amplifier installed in one of the mobile units  
with outside speaker.
  - 1,- remote control console for remote control of the base  
station with speaker and microphone.
  - 1,- station monitor receiver.
  - 1,- 5.8 gain antenna and feed line for base station transmitter
  - 2,- mobile receivers .
- The above prices to include installing.

Mr. Palmerston made motion to adopt resolution # 17 accepting  
this bid of Mr. Wold and General Electric. This resolution  
becoming part of these minutes, and also setting forth the  
acceptance conditions.
