The County Treasurers report shows a balance on hand of \$5345.70 with  
warrants in the amount of 206.93 outstanding as of August 31.

There was discussion regarding a light bill of \$ 42.66 at the Baty  
residence where the base radio station is located. Mr Baty SR. is living  
there now and the account had not been changed over to skedule 7 until the bill  
had come and it was realized that the skedule 20 was running the bill up too  
fast. Hunter reported that the account had since been changed to sked 7.

Mr. Henny suggested that Mr. Andrews of the Puget Sound Power & Light Company  
be contacted and see if they would make an adjustment on the bill to bring it  
in line with what it should be.

Hunter reported that he and Mr. Millman were working every day on the new  
part of the building at the Freeland fire station site. Also reported that  
the Freeland Merchants association had turned \$ 500 over to the District  
to help with the building program.

Hunter reported that the budget for 1964 had been turned in to the proper  
officials at Coupeville.
