Regular meeting of the Commissioners November 5, 1959.

Meeting called to order at the home of the chairman
Mr. Palmerston, at 8.00 P.M.

signed.

Chief Hunter asked if anyone had contacted Mrs Martin of the
Whiteacres Rest Home to try and learn what her plans for the spot
where the Freeland fire station stands, are.
Mr Palmerston stated that he has been unable to make an appoint-
ment with her as yet, so we still dont know what our status is
in regard to the station remaining there.

Hunter reported that he had talked to Clinton Freestone who
said he had talked to Mr. Mecklenberg the County Assessor who
suggested that he deed the lot where the Saratoga fire station
stands to Island County, in order to clear it of any further taxes.
Hunter recommended to Freestone that rather than do that to deed it to the
Fire District. Freestone said he would do this by instructing Mrs.
Raffalo his business agent to do this.

The State Auditors report of his examination of the accounts
of the District is on hand and was examined by the Commissioners
and was accepted. The report complimented the Commissioners on
the way they were conducting the business of the District.

Chief Hunter reported that he could purchase a used 2 H p siren
from L.N. Curtis & Sons for \$ 125.00. It is badly needed in the
District, either at Bush Point, Freeland, Saratoga.

Mr Palmerston made motion which was seconded , to permit Hunter
to purchase the siren to be paid for next April.

No further business meeting was adjourned at 9.00 P.M.
