Current bills in the amount of \$ 3081.81 are on hand and examined, and Mr. Long makes motion seconded by Mr. Capp that they be allowed and vouchers approved and signed, carried. They are listed on the reverse side this sheet.

County treasurers report is on hand and shows taxes collected in the amount of \$1742.45 for the expense fund during the month of September with a balance of \$6309.57 with warrants in the amount of 336.74 outstanding as of 30 September, for a net balance of \$5972.83 The G.O. bond fund shows taxes collected in the amount of \$933.64 making a balance of \$4013.84 There is \$16,000.00 of this fund invested and will be due back into the fund in October.

Under new business, the Chief requests that a hydraulic floor jack of two tom capacity be purchased for use in the shop in connection with servicing of the District equipment. One can be had from Sears Roebuck for \$ 180.00 plus tax and shipping, which is approximately \$ 50.00 less than can be had from amy of the auto supply houses.

Mr. Long makes motion seconded by Mr. Capp that Hunter be authorized to order same. Carried.

Hunter earlier in the meeting had reported that the new large doors had been installed in the Freeland station and were working very satisfactorily.

There was no further business and meeting was adjourned at 7.45
