Regular meeting of the Commissioners March 10, 1960

Meeting called to order at the home of the distict secretary  
Mr Hunter at 8.00 P.M.

Commissioners present; James T. Malone  
Lloyd S. Capp

Mr. Malone asked if Chief Hunter had any coats he deemed best suited for  
the need, Hunter stated he did not want to buy the heaviest coats as  
they were too warm to work in.

Hunter reported to teh commissioners that the work load was increasing to  
the point where he would have to have more time to devote to the district  
business, and that he was using all the sparet time he had plus some other  
time, and that in the not too distant future someone would have to be  
employed at least half time or more to take care of the work.  
Hunter also stated that he felt that if he was on a large part of the time  
or full time he could build a water tanker for the district and could  
save about \$ 5000.00 by so doing.

There was disscus ion of the G.E. radio , and Hunter reported the district  
had received a check for \$ 2732.55 for the Civil Defense half of the  
radio, and also sug ests that the district pay the balance with acash  
warrant to bring the balance down to an even \$ 1000.00 and issue a  
5 % Coupon warrant for the balance.

It was disscussed and decided to put it over to the April meeting  
so Mr Palmerston could have a voice in the decision as to what to do

No further business meeting was adjourned at 9.20 P.M.
