

ISLAND COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT No 3

Regular meeting of the Commissioners January 5, 1961

Meeting called to order at 8.15 P M by the chairman Mr. Malone, at the telephone office at Bayveiw.

Commissioners present : Mr. James T. Malone
Mr. Lloyd S Capp

Minutes of the last Commissioner meeting on December 1, 1960 read and approved as read.

Current bills considered and vouchers approved and signed.

Chief Hunter brought up the question of the telephone and siren rates for the district. He had on hand three proposals from the telephone company, for the tentative rates to apply at present. The siren line rates for the three proposals were identical ie. \$ 4.75 per month for each siren. Proposal No 1 were to have private lines at Clinton and Freeland and ten party lines at Bush Point, Saratoga, and Maxwellton for the phones. The two private lines would be \$ 6.25 each per month, the three ten party phones would be \$ 4.75 per month each. A line to Midvale for operation of the remote control for the radio base station would be an additional \$ 15.00 per month.


Chief Hunter also mentioned a private line to his place for fire district proposes which would cost ~~and~~ and an additional \$12.25 per month.

Mr. Capp made motion and it was seconded that we try out proposal # 1 which is: Freeland, Clinton, private lines @ 6.25 ea \$ 12.50 per mo.
Maxwelton, Bush point, and Saratoga 10 party " 4.75 " \$ 14.25 " "
All five sirens private lines " 4.75 " \$ 23.75 " "
Remote control line to Midvale "15.00 \$ 15.00 " "
Total \$ 65.50 " "

Chief Hunter said he needed a duplicator for getting out multi copies of various items and requested permission to purchase same. Stated he could get a spirit duplicator at Black & Kings for \$ 37.50 which would be satisfactory.

Mr. Capp made motion which was seconded to permit Hunter to buy a duplicator.

There being no further business meeting was adjourned at 9:15 P M.
