

Mr. Graff is the only one of the four bidders present and is now asked what he would expect of the Commissioners. He asks for a tentative figure on cost of construction of the station. This was quoted at approximately \$52,000.00. He says the Commissioners would also need to provide a survey of the site. Mr. Graff has with him a picture of MacLean road fire station in Skagit County # 2 which he designed.

At this time Mr. Graff is requested to retire to the Chiefs office so the Commissioners might discuss the various bids. After discussion, inasmuch as Mr. Graff's bid spells out in detail what services he will provide, and they seem to be very complete, a decision is reached to accept his bid.

Mr. Long now makes motion seconded by Mr. Capp that being as the Commissioners feel it is in the best interests of the District to hire an architect, and that Mr. Graff's bid was the best of the four submitted, to award the contract to Mr. Graff, carried unanimously.

The Chief had been requested earlier to call Mr. Gabelein to enquire if he could join the meeting to discuss exchange of lots. Mr. Gabelein arrives at 7:55 P. M.

There is some discussion and Mr. Gabelein agrees to exchange a lot further west for the lot presently owned by the District if he can get the zoning reversed on the two lots. The size of this lot to be 147 feet by 135 feet.

Business is now concluded and meeting is adjourned at 8:32 P. M.
