

In connection with the new receivers purchased for siren and door control at Freeland, Bayview and Saratoga stations the Chief states that they came equipped with alerting lights. He says he will take them back to Alden Equipment Company to have these removed as they are not necessary for this purpose.

The Secretary now states the need for a better copier than the one the District now has as the need for more and better copies is increasing. In looking into copiers, Alpine Office Equipment Company has offered an Olivetti Model 405 copier with all the required features at a price of \$1,095.00, which is a reduction of \$300.00 from the regular price of \$1,395.00. This copier will reduce the cost of copies approximately 60%, ~~also~~ also more convenient, faster and much better copies.. This is discussed and Mr. McClellan makes motion seconded by Mr. Long authorizing the Secretary to purchase the Olivetti Model 405 copier, 5 cases of copy paper at \$30.00 per case, 2 cases of toner at \$19.95 per case and a used copier stand at \$25.00, carried unanimously.

The Secretary requests changing the firemen reimbursement to be figured to November 1st instead of the present December 1st in order to be able to mail the checks to the firemen by December 1st. This is agreed to by the Commissioners and Chief.

Business is now concluded and meeting is adjourned at 8:38 P. M.
