REGULAR MEETING OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS, April 3, 1980

Gary Gabelein reported on his visit of the Langley open house for their new fire truck. It was brought out that they would keep the District high pressure pumper #943, at their expense for upkeep, until such time that the District may want to dispose of it as surplus.

Kenneth McClellan moved that the District advertise for bids to have the roof remodeled at the Maxwellton station along the lines of the work done last year on the Clinton station, Gary Gabelein seconded the motion, motion carried.
