This meeting called to open bids on new truck proposed to be purchased by the district.

Representatives from three companies were present and submitted bids. They were Mr. Robert Givens of the Givens Company
Mr. Byron Walker of the L.N. Curtis & Sons
Mr. W.S. Ashbrook of the Howard Cooper Corporation

The three bids presented were opened and read.

The first was the Givens Company \$12,090 plus sales tax and less \$ 225.00 for factory delivery. F 800 Ford

The next was L.N. Curtis & Sons, \$10,763.86 G.M.C. plus sales tax less \$ 10,434.61 Chev. " " " "


Ladders & Underwriters test \$185.00. With option to take 1957 model at a probable price increase of about 5 % .

Next was Howard Cooper Corporation \$ 9,920.00 including sales tax. With the same option as the Curtis bid on choice of chassis of G.M.C.

Each bidder was given a few minutes to explain his bid and answer questions. The Givens and Curtis bids were for front mounted Pumps and Howard Cooper bid for midship mounted Hale pump.

Motion made and seconded to meet on Tuesday Oct, 23 to discuss the bids and perhaps act on them.

No further business considered and meeting was adjourned at 9.20 P.M.
